INTRODUCTION

Luke's record of the Spirit's coming at Pentecost (Acts 2) is exciting. There is wind and fire, and the world is turned upside down. John's account (John 20.19-23) is set at Easter and appears much quieter. In both, though, there is a sense of preparation as the disciples are equipped for future ministry. The key is that the Spirit will guide them into all the truth (John 16.13). The experience of two thousand years bears this out, as the Spirit continually reveals new truth about God, with more yet to be discovered. This is exciting, as much as was the first Pentecost.
